Activity:

Read: 1 John 3:1-2

This passage shows us how God wants us to be his children and that when we become His children we become different from the world. When we become part of his family we become different and accept special responsibilities that are only given to God's children.

Questions:

- Do you view God as your father?

- Does God and your worldly father or male role model have the same characteristics?
