

## Devotion Day 6

The last devotional went into how we should go and be witnesses to whoever. Now we will dive into a very specific topic that lots of people have about missions. This devotion's topic is that God is existent to Whoever.

Read through the devotional and answer the questions.

### Activity:

Answer these questions yourself, then get friends or family to answer them and see how many match up.

- If you could bring 5 things to an island in the middle of the ocean, what would you bring?
- If you could take one person with you, who would you bring?
- If you could bring an infinite amount of one food, which food would it be?
- How long do you think you could last alone on an island?

Some people in the world today still live in very remote areas which have never been visited by modern people.

Despite this, God is still present, and they are not without the Gospel.

### Read: Romans 1:20-21 & Acts 28:1-10

The major question is, "how can people in remote locations ever know who Jesus or God is?". Well, if we look to Romans 1:20, we find our answer; see, it says that God can be seen in everything because God created the whole earth and all of nature. But verse 21 says that people see that and turn away from that idea trying their way. In Acts 28, we see Paul being transported as a prisoner to Rome, where he will be put on trial. On his way there, his

ship is destroyed on a small island south of Italy called Malta. This small island had a lot of local people who most likely did not speak the common language of Greek, but there were a few Romans there too. This island probably did not get to see too many people from the outside world and had never heard of the gospel. We see that when the locals witness Paul being bitten by a deadly snake, they think he is a God. See, the locals have an idea that God or a higher power exists; this is found in verse 6, as they call him a God. But Paul is not a God, and he goes on to heal people on the island showing the true God's amazing power. Through these passages, we see how God is existent to Whoever.

**Questions:**

- Can you see God in nature and creation? How so?
- Do you think if no one told you about God, you would be able to find him? Whether people have heard the gospel or not, God still wants them. He makes himself present to those everywhere. This is all because God is existent to Whoever.
